










Apotheosis (from Greek ἀποθέωσις from ἀποθεοῦν, apotheoun "to deify"; in Latin deificatio "making divine"; also called divinization and deification) is the glorification of a subject to divine level. The term has meanings in theology, where it refers to a belief, and in art, where it refers to a genre.

In theology, apotheosis refers to the idea that an individual has been raised to godlike stature. In art, the term refers to the treatment of any subject (a figure, group, locale, motif, convention or melody) in a particularly grand or exalted manner.



Tisha B'Av

♠ Tisha B'Av (neb virio) (III, "the ninth of Av") (Hebrew: axa nuwn or axa o) is an annual fast day in Judalsm which commemorates the anniversary of a number of disasters in Jewish history, primarily the destination of both the First and Second Temples in Jewasiem.
This B B'Av is regarded as the sadded wity in the Jewish cander and it is this believed to be a day which is destined for tragedy. If III Tisha B'Av falls in July or August in the Western

cuernars. The observance of the day includes five prohibitions, most notable of which is a 25-hour fast. The Bock of Lamentalisms, which mourns the destruction of Jerusalems is read in the synagogue, followed by the recitation of kinnor, flurgical dirges that lament the loss of the Temple and Jerusalem. As the day has become associated with remembrance of other major calamities which have befallen the Jevish people, some kinnor also recall sevents such as the murder of the Ten Matry, massacres in numerous medieval Jevish communities during the Crusades and the Holocaust.
